



BIG SKY ADVENTURE MAP

KNOW THE CODE. IT'S YOUR RESPONSIBILITY.

1. Always stay in control. You must be able to stop or avoid people or objects.
2. People ahead or downhill of you have the right-of-way. You must avoid them.
3. Stop only where you are visible from above and do not restrict traffic.
4. Look uphill and avoid others before starting downhill or entering a trail.
5. You must prevent runaway equipment.
6. Read and obey all signs, warnings, and hazard markings.

Winter sports involve risk of serious injury or death. Your knowledge, decisions, and actions contribute to your safety and that of others. If you need help understanding the Code, please ask any ski area employee.

7. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
8. You must know how and be able to load, ride, and unload lifts safely. If you need assistance, ask the lift attendant.
9. Do not use lifts or terrain when impaired by alcohol or drugs.
10. If you are involved in a collision or accident, share your contact information with each other and a ski area employee.

LEGEND

Look for the outline color in the characters on the map. You will find green, blue, and black colors which represent the run difficulty. Remember to start small with green runs and work your way up to blue, double blue, black, and then double black!
